Gooseberries, nectarine and a whisper of sage

Maldonado, Uruguay // 47
Peaches, white flowers & a bracing minerality

BLANK CANVAS, GRÜNER VELTLINER 2015

Malborough, New Zealand // 55
Cellar aged to produce white pepper, ginger & a zippy little finish

DOMAINE DE NOGENT, VIRÉ-CLESSÉ CHABLIS 2019

Chablis, France // 70
A stripped back approach to Chardonnay that lets the purity of fruit do the talking

COLUMBIA CREST, GRANT ESTATES, CHARDONNAY 2021

Washington Estate, USA // 11.5 • 48
This Chardonnay opens with intense fresh fruit aromas of apples, pears, and melons, joined by signature characters of crème brûlée, caramel and graham cracker. Ripe orchard fruit flavors are joined by creamy, buttery notes and balanced by lively acidity.

RISKY GRAPES, LA TRACA TINTO 2020

Valencia, Spain// 43
Explosive flavours of cherry & a subtle kiss of anise on the finish

JOURNEY'S END V2, MERLOT

Stellenbosch, South Africa// 11.5 • 48
Gentle, ripe fruit on the palate, with firm tannins and a supple sweetness that gives the wine a lingering aftertaste; it is full-bodied and complex.

PHINCAS, RIOJA ALAVESA, TEMPRANILLO 2017

Rioja, Spain// 75
A broad wine that opens up into brambles, herbs, vanilla & clove

VIEUX CHEVALIER, CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE, GRENACHE 2018

Rhône, France// 113
Deep & dark, this bottle serves up figs, leather & ripe dark berries

CLOUDY BAY, PINOR NOIR 2020

Malborough, New Zealand// 90
From a winery that put Marlborough on the map, an iconic offering of new world Pinot

A TO Z WINEWORKS PINOT NOIR 2018

Oregon, USA// 64
Ripeness and concentration of the vintage with an uncommon grace and style. The compelling nose opens with vibrant notes of blackberry, blueberry, black cherry, raspberry, strawberry, red current, plum, thyme, sage and baking spices.

MARUXA MENCÍA

Valdeorras, Spain// 11.75 • 50
A brilliant clean red cherry colour and an explosion of aromas on the nose: intense fresh red fruit, mineral and earthy. In the mouth, the wine is broad and fresh with a good acidity.

MONCLIVIO, ENRICO SERAFINO, BAROLO 2017

Piedmont, Italy// 125
Intensely elegant nose, with red fruit and spicy notes of liquorice and vanilla; the palate is austere with smooth tannins and a freshness to the finish.

LA DAMA, AMARONE DELLA VALPOLICELLA, CORVINA 2017

Veneto, Italy// 110
Silky & rich, this Amarone is unapologetic in its power

BODEGAS NUMANTIA, TINTA DE TORO 2016

Castilla y León, Spain// 125
Super concentrated fruit packed into a big heavy-duty wine

VIETTI, PERBACCO, NEBBIOLO 2019

Piedmont, Italy // 65
An intense wine with harmoniously integrated tannins, medium-bodied but high impact

TERRAZAS SELECTION MALBEC

Uco Valley, Argentina// 13 • 55
Bright red colour with purple hues, it has an intense floral and fruity aroma with notes of violets, black cherry and plum. Distinct toast and spice notes, with hints of black pepper and chocolate. Juicy on the palate with delicate tannins and medium body.

LOUIS FELIPE EDWARDS MERLOT

Valle de Colchagua, Chile// 55
Fruity. It's got incredible intensity from ripening in the Colchagua sun. Think strawberry, black cherry and cassis. A lovely ripe, velvety texture complements this moreish fruitiness.

RITME, PRIORAT

Priorat, Spain// 95
Fresh, nice and light wine with a good persistent.

PETH WETZ, UNFILTERED PINOT NOIR

Rheinhesen, Germany// 16.5 • 70
This distinctive, unfiltered, German Pinot displays notes of bright red cherry, blueberry, clove, black tea leaf and cinnamon are consistent from the nose to the palate, where they are met by crisp acidity and round tannins. The complexity of this wine will continue to evolve over time.

CHATEAU CANTENAC-BROWN, 2006

Margaux, France// 200
The wine of a great purity is very precise. It is unequivocally one of the great achievements of the vintage.

CHATEAU D'ISSAN, 2007

Margaux, France// 180
A light to medium-bodied, pretty, but slightly austere wine, this dark ruby-hued 2007 reveals spicy berry fruit and tobacco leaf notes, and a soft, round style.

FAMILIA ZUCCARDI BRAZOS MALBEC, 2007

Uco Valley, Argentina// 95
Dark violet with blue hues with typical Malbec aromas reminiscent of ripe red and black fruits as cherries, plums and blackberries. Medium bodied, with soft tannins and balanced acidity. Fruity and spicy finish.
